

Botox Halifax

Botox Halifax - By definition, a wrinkle is a fold, ridge or crease in the skin. Skin wrinkles usually appear as a result of the processes of aging, comprising: glycation or even from the prolonged immersion of the skin in water. Skin wrinkling is caused by sun damage, aging, poor hydration, smoking, habitual facial expressions and various other elements. Skin wrinkles in the water due to extended water exposure that causes the outer layer of skin to absorb water. Depletion of water in the body like with dehydration likewise can lead to the puckering of the skin. Cortisol is one more factor which causes degradation of skin collagen.

To remedy wrinkles as well as other skin depressions, dermal fillers are often used. There are products which are injectable into the soft tissues. Dermal fillers are meant to enable injection into the skin for reasons of enhancing the appearance of the skin. The most popular products are based on hyaluronic acid.

Botulinum Toxin

The neurotoxin protein, botulinum toxin, is made by the bacterium *Clostridium botulinum*. The most common kind of botulinum toxin is called onabotulinumtoxinA or "Botox". This particular type of botulinum toxin is made by Allergan Inc. for both cosmetic and therapeutic usage. Botox is used in the treatment of migraine headache and spasmodic dystonia or spasmodic torticollis which is a neuromuscular disorder that involves the head and neck. Botox has many uses along with its cosmetic application.

During the year 2009, American people now had a new obtainable kind of botulinum toxin. This new kind, manufactured by Ipsen, is referred to as Dysport or abotulinumtoxinA. It has been given FDA approval and is currently made use of to treat glabellar lines in adults as well as cervical dystonia. Dysport and Botox on the other hand, are not interchangeable as the molecular structure of the two drugs is different.

The Botulinum toxin can treat a lot of wrinkles by relaxing or immobilizing the muscles that lead to wrinkles. This toxin is not appropriate for the remedy of all wrinkles, as is seen with glabellar lines, which happen between the eyebrows in adults. Whatever other use of this toxin is considered "off-label" use and is not FDA approved.
